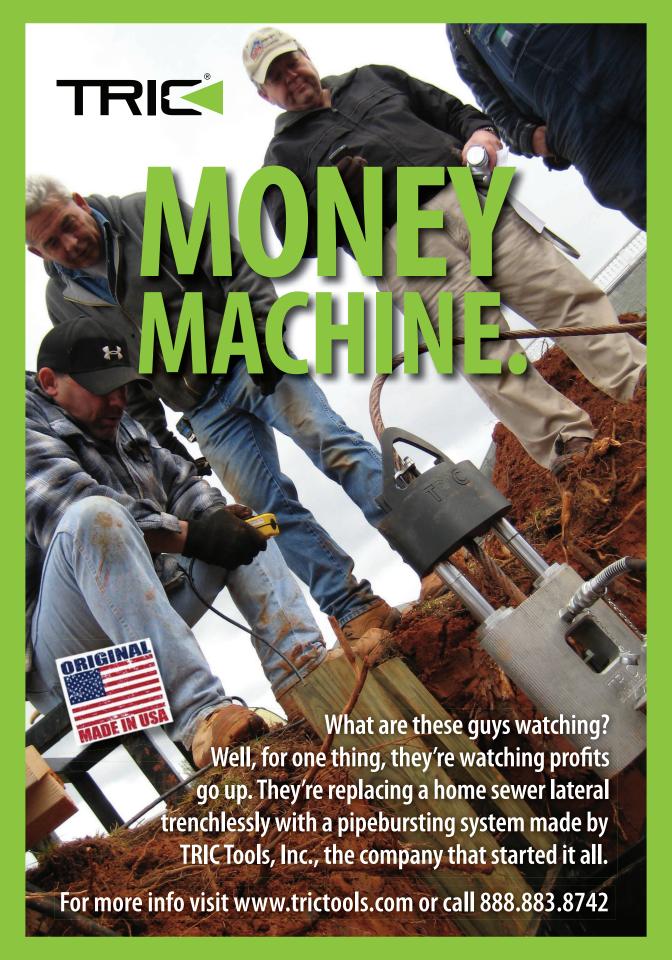

or more than 40 years, Bulldog Contractors in Jefferson, Texas, has relied on a simple formula for success: Adapt to changing market conditions, invest in advanced technologies, provide great customer service and build a diversified business that's a one-stop shop for customers.

The company's transition decades ago from a residential-remodeling general contractor to a plumbing firm reflects its ability to change with the times. Owner Carl Keller, who established the East Texas company in 1978, made the switch to survive, not by choice. But it turned out to be a

fortuitous move for both Keller, who's semiretired and still owns the company, and his son, Jeff Keller, who now runs it.

The change was prompted by small-town politics, as local plumbers preferred to work for other general contractors in town instead of Bulldog. "They didn't want us to get business, so they priced our jobs so high that we couldn't compete as a general contractor," Jeff says.

Undaunted, Carl fought back by getting a plumber's license in the early 1990s. That enabled him to do plumbing work himself. The strategy worked so well that the company eventually morphed into a plumbing business.

"We eventually got so overloaded and crazy busy with service work that we dropped the remodeling and went into full-blown plumbing and drain cleaning work," says Jeff, age 32. "Business was great, and the profit margins were much better than remodeling work, too."

Plumbing services currently generate about 65% of the company's revenue, while septic-related services contribute the rest, he says.

PUMPING IN THE MIX. TOO

Around the same time the company started moving into plumbing work, it also entered the arena for septic tank pumping and septic system service and repairs. The rationale for the move was simple: In rural East Texas, Carl Keller, left, and Jeff Keller install a Rheem water heater at a residence in Jefferson, Texas.

most homes still have septic systems. And if a customer has a plumbing issue, the odds are roughly 50-50 that it's either a plumbing or septic system issue, Jeff says.

"We wanted to be a one-stop shop for our customers," he says. "No matter what the problem is, we want to be able to take care of it, right then and there."

As such, it's not unusual for Bulldog to send a vacuum truck and a plumbing vehicle to rural job sites, just to avoid making customers wait for service. Jeff charges customers more to bring both vehicles, but he gives them the option of bringing just one truck or both.

"If people tell me it's been a long time since their tank was pumped, I can pretty much predict what the problem is," he says. "We usually take both trucks with us so we don't have to backtrack and cost customers time.

"If they haven't had the tank pumped in, say, 10 years or more, they're going to need that done anyway," he continues. "I usually try to pump the tank first,

and if that doesn't fix the problem, then we've got a plumbing truck parked right there."

Jeff is manufacturer-certified to repair and service 13 different kinds of aerobic systems. On the rare occasion that the company installs a new septic system, Jeff says he prefers Clearstream Wastewater Systems, using either concrete or fiberglass tanks supplies by Clearstream, he says.

LARGE ARRAY OF EQUIPMENT

Fixing a variety of plumbing and septic issues, from neglected septic tanks to clogged drains, requires a stable of reliable equipment. Bulldog has built a reputation for having the right machine for the job, which Jeff says is necessary to provide great customer service.

Unorthodox business strategy: Pumping the brakes on growth

For many business owners, growth is the be-all and end-all objective after starting a business — the ultimate benchmark for measuring success. After all, bigger is better, right?

Not always, as Carl Keller, the owner of Bulldog Contractors, and his son, Jeff Keller, can attest. Carl established Bulldog in Jefferson, Texas, in 1978. And by 1985, the company grew to 22 employees and was running three plumbing service trucks, plus a vacuum truck used to pump out septic tanks.

But while growth can be great, it can also spur hassles and headaches, too, including mounting overhead costs and increased personnel and managerial responsibilities that suck up that most precious of commodities: time.

So with all those factors and the growing difficulty of finding qualified technicians, the company took a less-is-more approach about 10 years ago and started downsizing, Jeff explains.

"It got harder and harder to find good, reliable workers who you can trust with your company name and brand," he says. "In fact, nowadays it's hard to find someone who'll just show up to work. We got tired of all the babysitting — it just wasn't worth all the headaches.

"You reach a breaking point when you spend so much more time managing people and your overhead costs just keep getting bigger and bigger," he adds. "And even though you're bigger, you aren't making any more money than when you were smaller."

Today, the company has just three employees: the two Kellers (Carl is semiretired) and Cameron Corpier, a technician who's been with the firm for six years. Bulldog also runs only one plumbing service truck — a Chevrolet Express cutaway van with a 12-foot box body made by Supreme (a company owned by Wabash National).

"We have a lot fewer headaches because now there's no need to always be checking up on everyone out in the field," explains Jeff, who grew up in the business and always planned on working for his father. "And my father could finally step away from working out in the field."

"The industry is constantly changing," he points out. "If you don't adapt and change with the way it's evolving — and the plumbing industry is exploding with new innovation — then you're going to be left behind, plain and simple. We try to keep up with most innovative tools and technology."

On the septic side of the business, the company relies on a 1996 International truck outfitted with a 1,650-gallon steel tank made by Lely Tank & Waste Solutions and a vacuum pump made by National Vacuum Equipment.

To do repairs and system installations (the company only installs a handful of new septic systems a year), as well as replace waterlines and sewer lines, the company also owns a JCB backhoe, a trencher made by Ditch Witch and a 35-foot flatbed trailer made by McLendon Trailers.

For plumbing, the company owns a 2017 Chevrolet Express cutaway van with a 12-foot box body made by Supreme (a company owned by Wabash National) and storage and shelving units built by Hackney. The company also relies on power tools made by RIDGID and Milwaukee Tool.

For drain cleaning, the company invested in a RIDGID Standard SeeSnake pipeline inspection camera, SeeSnake microReel camera, RIDGID SR-60 SeekTech pipeline locator and cart-mounted JM-2900 water jetter (4 gpm at 3,000 psi) built by General Pipe Cleaners/General Wire Spring.

In addition, the company owns a RIDGID K-6200 drum machine (for 3- to 6-inch-diameter pipes) and an M18 Drain Snake manufactured by Milwaukee Tool.

ADEOUATE PRICES ARE CRITICAL

How is Bulldog able to afford so much equipment? By charging prices that are high enough to cover overhead costs, as well as generate sufficient profit margins that enable the company to keep reinvesting in more tools and equipment that boost efficiency and productivity.

A good example is pipeline inspection cameras, which Jeff says are among the smartest purchases he's ever made. The main benefit: The ability to see and diagnose problems without tearing up customers' yards to find the problem, he notes.

The cameras make company technicians look more professional and help sell jobs because customers can actually see a problem. To recover the cost of expensive video equipment, Jeff charges an add-on fee to camera lines. As he puts it, "There's nothing free in this world."

But he only offers it as an option, and Jeff gives customers a free one-year warranty on work if a post-cleaning camera inspection shows a line is running free and clear and the pipeline system is in good working order, he adds.

But in the end, it's hard to make equipment investments by charging just below or about what competitors charge. "I charge based on what a job is worth and how long it'll take me to finish it," he says.

SOCIAL MEDIA CONNECTIONS

One way Jeff stays on top of plumbing innovations is through a Facebook group called Plumbing Hacks and Plumbing Professional Discussions. When Jeff first joined the closed group (wannabes need to apply for membership),



it consisted of 300 to 400 plumbers. Now it has just under 33,000 members and has expanded to include not only licensed plumbers, but also product manufacturers and industry representatives, Jeff says.

"Its goal is to educate and uplift the trade," says Jeff, who has served as a moderator for the Facebook page. "I've learned a lot of things over the years, from marketing tips to new products, and met a lot of great people. There's a real sense of camaraderie here.

"Everyone learns from the group and implements tips and knowledge gained into their own businesses," he continues. "There's so much knowledge that's literally priceless. I hate other kinds of social media, but this is an awesome networking tool."

While investments in advanced technology helps provide great customer service, it's not the only factor in gaining repeat business. Jeff says Bulldog technicians strive to treat customers and their homes they way they'd want to be treated.

"When customers call, they're putting all their trust and faith in your company," Jeff says. "They're trusting you with a major investment in their property, whether it's a plumbing system or septic system."

LITTLE THINGS MAKE A DIFFERENCE

As an example of a little thing that pays big customer-service dividends, Jeff says the company provides customers with a series of arrival windows, which gradually get narrower as the appointment draws near. During an initial call, for instance, a customer might be told to expect a technician between, say, 8 and 10 a.m., Jeff explains.

But the day before the service call, the customer gets another call to make sure the time still works — and to narrow down the arrival window to between 30 minutes and an hour. "That's because by then I have a better idea of how things will shake out," he says.

On the morning of the call, a technician will call ahead and narrow that arrival window even further, usually down to 10 or 15 minutes. "It's all about efficiency — not wasting your customers' time and also keeping them happy," he says.

Jeff says customer service is always top of mind, especially since the company often gets calls from customers who are disgruntled about the service provided by the last plumber they used. Moreover, he also notes that most service calls come from word-of-mouth referrals, which reduce the need for expensive marketing campaigns.

Educating customers also helps spur repeat business, especially on the septic side of the company. Customer education also helps with price objections, because when customers understand everything that goes into a job, they better understand the costs involved, he adds.

BETTER WORK-LIFE BALANCE

Looking ahead, Jeff says he will eventually buy the company from his father. But that won't change the company's less-is-more business strategy, which prompted a gradual downsizing during the last 10 years. Growing smaller instead of larger allowed the company to operate at a saner pace and pay even more attention to customer service, he says.

"I'm not looking for the headaches that come from more growth," he says. "There was a time when I was married to the business, with no life and no family time.

A Different Approach

Distributors, suppliers and dealers all offer options for contractors looking to purchase new equipment **By Tim Dobbins**

urchasing equipment or new plumbing tools can be difficult in today's market where it seems like there are countless options available. Getting knowledgeable and unbiased reviews before buying is invaluable for your business.

Contacting manufacturers directly for advice can provide information about a specific product, but it does not always give the buyer comparisons to other options. Going through suppliers, dealers or distributors is a way contractors can get some of those comparisons.

Suppliers carry a large inventory of products from multiple manufacturers and not only provide a product, but also service to go with it.

KNOWLEDGEABLE SERVICE

For contractors, the convenience and efficiency of shopping in one location versus multiple stores saves time and money. Having a plethora of choices also gives the buyer a chance to directly compare and contrast similar models of different brand names to find what works best for their personal situation.

"We're a one-stop shop where contractors can get everything from one source," says Gary Allen, CEO of Jetter Depot. "We can put a package together, whether it's a jetter, a camera system, whatever. That way when they get on the job, they have everything they need."

Jetter Depot offers equipment such as jetters, pressure washer nozzles, hoses, cameras, manhole/pipe tools and other similar items. Along with carrying an extensive line of product and brand names, what separates a lot of suppliers even more is the well-rounded knowledge of the industry that comes from the equipment they supply and their personal experience that goes with it.

"We use the contractor experience we have to support the product lines we carry," says Andy Rothenberg, Prime-Line Products president. "People know that if they come to us, they are going to get the support they need."

The company's expertise isn't specialized in one area

or brand name, but spread out over numerous product lines it truly believes in, from sewer and lateral lining and repair to testing equipment and chemical grouting and more. "We've got the knowledge, because we've actually done the jobs," Allen says. "And I think customers appreciate that."

The knowledge diversity comes in handy when contractors call looking for answers to a specific problem.

"We get a lot of phone calls where they are just looking for a solution," Rothenberg says. "Having the broad product line and the experience separates us. They know that they can call us and get an answer and solution."

Knowing the importance of getting the job done in a timely manner, dealers will also commonly use special delivery services to help the customer get what they need as fast as possible. "We offer a Hot Shot delivery service," says Keith Jones, president of Central Oklahoma Winnelson. "Meaning you call in an order and it is loaded and out the door immediately."

Central Oklahoma Winnelson offers many plumbing-related products in its inventory from water heaters to fixtures, power tools and pumps.

CONTINUED SUPPORT

Service doesn't stop with the sale. Several dealers and distributors also provide training and demonstration on products they carry.

"We have a 1,000-square-foot training center that we are able to offer classes in," Jones says. "Our customers love



the fact that we offer training classes and there are a lot of times that we get them approved for continuing education credits through the state."

These training sessions not only help customers leave with the necessary equipment to get the job done, but also provide the know-how to go with it, leaving less room for error in the field. Not only do distributors regularly offer training, it is not uncommon to find full equipment repair and technical support services.

"We've got a 5,000-square-foot warehouse, repair center and loading dock for repairing trucks and engines," Allen says. Jones says his company is able to offer technical support for roughly 500 manufacturers.

A knowledgeable dealer's ability to provide a product to a customer along with training and support — and, if necessary, repair — separate their services and keep customers coming back.

"We are trained to never tell the customer 'no' and to do whatever it takes to get our customers an answer," Jones says. "We understand that if our customers are not here, we don't exist."

Having that attitude in the world of customer service builds relationships and trust. "I think relationships are a lot of it," Rothenberg says. "I consider a lot of my customers my friends. They know that if they call me with an issue and want me there, I will jump on a plane and get there. That's just the level of service we provide."


Hot-water recirculating purnss generate revenue, save customers money **By Ken Wysocky**

t's not unusual for plumbers to feel unconfortable about upselling customers on items above and beyond the repair needed. But hot-water recirculating pumps offer an easy win-win situation for both customers and plumbers — as long as it's an upsell, not a hard self.

That's the message from Dale Armstrong, the owner of TLC Plumbing & Utility in Albuquerque, New Mexico. Established in 1987, the company instalis thousands of recirculating pumps every year, mostly H1.5-2 Hot-Link units built by Taco Comfort Solutions.

"Taco is a very reliable pump," Armstrong says. "It's been a standard in the industry for a long time, so they're tried-and-true devices. We have very few issues with them, which is important. Nobody likes callbacks."

In addition, the company semetimes uses Comfort PM hot-water recirculating pumps manufactured by Grundfos for applications in older homes that don't have a recirculating loop plumbed into them. Typical cost for a recirculating pump and installation is about \$500, Armstrong says.



Saving significant amounts of water that are usually wasted while waiting for hot water to arrive at a faucet or showerhead is a great selling point. Customers also save money by using less water, not to mention less naturalgas usage, he adds.

A typical showerhead, for example, probably wastes about 2 1/2 to 5 gallons of water per shower while waiting for het water, which comes out to about 900 gallons a year. The U.S. Department of Energy estimates that an average size household wastes about 12,000 gallons annually while waiting for hot water.

But there's another even greater cost: Wasting an already scarce resource — especially in an arid desert area like New Mexico. "If you're turning on faucets and just letting them run, you're adding to the problem of wasting a limited natural resource," Armstrong points out.

In a normal-size household with average water usage, a hot-water recirculating pumps will pay for itself after about one year. "But the added convenience is also worth quite a bit to customers," he adds.

CASUAL APPROACH

So what's the best way to ask if a customer is interested in such an upgrade? At TLC, which employs nearly 600 people and does residential and commercial service and repair, drain cleaning and trenchless pipeline rehab statewide, technicians are trained to ask lifestyle questions to identify products that could benefit customers, Armstrong explains.

For example, while repairing a faucet, a technician might ask a customer how long it takes to get hot water to the tap. If the customer says it takes awhile, the technician can ask if hot water on-demand would be worth considering.

"Asking the question can lead to an easy conversation about what it would take to make that happen," he says. "But it's not a hard sell. We only provide more information if the customer is interested.

"We offer whatever is mission critical to fixing the existing problem — give customers a recommendation of what we'd do at our own home," he continues. "Then we make a recommendation for anything that could make their home operate better than it ever has in the past.

"That way the customer truly is deciding what he or she wants."

MAKING TIME FOR INSTALLS

How does TLC handle scheduling if customers decide they want a recirculating pump installed right away? Armstrong says the company schedules its 155 technicians with a little "wiggle room" to accommodate such situations.

"We schedule close to daily capacity, based on how many techs we're running and the season," he explains. "One advantage of having a group as big as ours is that there are a lot of resources available. If one guy stays on a job longer than anticipated, we just move that next call to somebody else.

"We like to send technicians out on just one call at a time," he continues. "That way they're not thinking about rushing through one job to get to the next job. They go to one call and satisfy all the wants and needs of that customer before moving on to the next one. The fewer trips we make, the more profitable we are."

The ability to respond to upsell approvals also depends on having parts on hand, which the company accomplishes with 16-foot box trucks that carry anywhere from \$7,000 to \$10,000 worth of parts inventory. The company relies primarily on Isuzu NPR trucks outfitted with box bodies made by Supreme (a Wabash National company).

As a former technician, Armstrong believes it's critical to educate customers and talk about their wants — and respect those wants. It's easy for plumbers to get caught up in what they believe a customer needs and ignore what the customer really wants.

"So just having a conversation about they want can make all the difference," he says about upselling. "I always tell our technicians that it's their job to know what customers want before they leave a job site. If they don't know that, they haven't done their job right."

Not Another Staff Meeting

You've all heard the groans, but well-planned staff meetings will make your business better Bv Kate Zabriskie

sit right next to them. We don't need to have a staff meeting.

I used to have staff meetings, but we stopped having them. Nobody had anything to talk about.

We have enough meetings. We certainly don't need another.

For a myriad reasons, many managers or smallbusiness owners don't hold regular staff meetings. Furthermore, most who do don't get the most they could from them, and that's too bad. Good staff meetings can focus a team, energize employees and engage them in ways that ad hoc interactions don't.

So how do you turn a halted or ho-hum approach to staff meetings into a high-functioning management tool?

Step 1: Connect Daily Work With Your Organization's Purpose

In addition to distributing information, staff meetings present an opportunity to connect your team's daily work to your company's purpose. If you think your people know how their work fits into the company's overall goal, you would be wrong. In fact, if you ask your employees what your organization's purpose is, don't be surprised when you get as many answers as there are people in the room. (And you thought you had nothing to talk about in a staff meeting! A discussion about purpose is a good one to have.)

Purpose is why you do what you do. You connect the work to the purpose by explaining how what people do aligns with the greater goal. For example, the head of housekeeping at a busy hotel might hold a meeting with the cleaning staff. In that meeting, the managers might recognize a team that received a perfect room score from all guests who took a survey and then talk about purpose.

The purpose of the hotel is to provide people a safe and comfortable place to spend the night. Having a clean, welcoming and functioning room is one of the ways a cleaning staff achieves that goal. By regularly connecting such activities as cleaning toilets, making beds and folding towels to the guest experience, the manager highlights why each of those activities is important.

Hotels and your plumbing work are no different. No matter what they do, employees usually enjoy their jobs more when their leaders talk about the importance of their work. They also tend to make better choices if they receive frequent reminders about purpose and what types of activities support it.

Step 2: Highlight Relevant Metrics

Connecting work to purpose usually works best when a team focuses on both anecdotal and analytical information. If you don't currently track statistics, start. What you track will depend on your industry. However, whatever you decide should have a clear line of sight to the larger goal. For example, a plumbing company might track on-time service records, positive or negative customer responses, or a rate of new customers or customer retention related to advertising or marketing efforts. With regular attention placed on the right metrics, the team is far more likely to make good choices as to where it should focus its efforts.

Step 3: Follow a Formula and Rotate Responsibility

Successful staff meetings usually follow a pattern, such as looking at weekly metrics, sharing information from the top, highlighting success, a team-building activity and so forth. By creating and sticking with a formula, managers help employees know what to expect. Once employees know the pattern of the meeting, many are capable of running it because they've learned by watching. Managers then have a natural opportunity to rotate the responsibility of the meeting to different people. By delegating, the manager frees up his or her time and provides employees with a chance to develop their skills.

Step 4: Celebrate Successes

In many organizations, there is a huge appreciation shortage. Staff meetings provide managers and employees with regular intervals to practice gratitude.

"Bob worked overtime replacing fixtures at a house on Saturday. Because of that, we got rave reviews for our service by the customer."

"Mary Ann's efficient routing of our vans when we were jammed with work on Friday got everyone home to their families for dinner and saved the company hundreds of dollars."

A steady drip of sincere gratitude can drive engagement. Note the word "sincere." Most people have an amazing capacity to identify a false compliment. Real praise is specific. Well-delivered praise also ties the action to the outcome. People appreciate praise more when they understand how their actions delivered results. A praise segment in your staff meetings ensures you routinely take the time to recognize efforts.

Step 5: Focus on Lessons Learned and Continuous Improvement

Staff meetings that include an opportunity to share lessons learned help drive continuous improvement. At first, people may be reluctant to share shortcomings. However, if you follow step four, you should begin to develop better communication and a sense of trust with your team. Modeling the process is a good place to start.

"I learned something this week that I want to share with you. I had a call with a customer that could have gone better. I'm going to tell you what happened, and then we'll discuss some ideas about how I would handle something similar in the future."

The more you practice this exercise, the greater the gains you should experience.

Step 6: Develop a Schedule and Stick With It

Almost anyone can follow the first five steps some of the time, but those who get the most out of staff meetings hold them consistently. They publish a meeting schedule, and they stick with it. They may shorten a meeting from time to time or reschedule, but they don't treat their chance to gather the team as a low priority.

Good staff meetings aren't perfunctory activities that add little value. On the contrary, when used to their full capacity, they are a dynamic management tool. Now what are you going to do about yours?

ulture of safety" is a phrase that gets used a For a lot of companies, it is a reality safety is paramount and deeply embedded in every part of the work they do. A dedicated safety manager puts together job hazard analyses before every job; workers are trained monthly on best practices and reminded daily to wear personal protective equipment; and work halts if even the slightest risk becomes apparent.

For others, safety might be given more lip service than actual practice.

There are a lot of additional resources that can help you provide training opportunities for your crew or add to what you're currently doing if you're weak in one area.

A lot companies probably fall somewhere in between. Safety is important to most companies. Keeping workers safe means productivity and profits, whereas injuries and accidents mean paperwork and downtime, or even fines from OSHA.

But adhering to safety rules when it suits you and having those rules permeate every part of your work environment are two different things. Safety training shouldn't just be required for new employees or restricted to monthly meetings. Training should be constant and ongoing in order to truly achieve that culture of safety.

June is National Safety Month, promoted by the National Safety Council, a nonprofit safety advocate that focuses on saving lives and preventing injuries in the workplace and beyond.

If your safety training could use some freshening up and you're not sure where to start, visit www.nsc.org. The council's website provides tipsheets, articles, social media graphics and more that are specific to National Safety Month, as well as others that are year-round safety training resources.

To help direct training during the month of June, the National Safety Council focuses on a specific topic each week:

June 1-7: Emergency Preparedness

When a medical emergency occurs, time is of the essence. Knowing and performing first aid and CPR can drastically increase a victim's chance of survival.

June 8-14: Driving

Motor vehicle crashes are the leading cause of death in the workplace. Whether you drive for your job or just for your commute, responsible roadway habits can keep everyone safe.

June 15-21: Ergonomics

Poor ergonomics can lead to overexertion, the leading cause of preventable workplace injury.

June 22-30: Employee Engagement

Complacent employees may be unaware of the hazards around them. Getting employees engaged can improve an organization's safety culture and performance.

There are a lot of additional resources that can help you provide training opportunities for your crew or add to what you're currently doing if you're weak in one area. It's easier than ever to get quality training materials.

The OSHA website offers training materials that plumbing companies can use to provide high-quality training opportunities for employees. Online, you can find publications, DVDs and videos for training, along with



stand-alone interactive, web-based training tools on occupational safety and health topics. Topics include confined-space entry, excavation and trenching, eye protection, bloodborne pathogens and much more. There's a whole library of resources right at your fingertips.

OSHA's Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response, or HAZWOPER, series of training programs for the handling of hazardous materials includes specific topics such as decontamination, emergency response plans and respiratory protection. The 24- and 40-hour courses cost far less than any accident, and there are even group discounts available for enrolling six or more employees. The eight-hour refresher course to renew certification is now available online.

And these aren't the only sources for safety training. Websites like www.compliancetrainingonline.com, www.360training.com, www.tpctraining.com and www.grainger.com all offer safety instruction and training options, and there are many other sites offering tips and news that can guide tailgate talks about job site safety.

Lighting the Fire

Learning the importance of proper combustion in the modern home can go a long way in giving customers long-lasting products Bv Anthony Pacilla

nortly after the cave man made a fire in his cave, the first two combustion issues were realized. How do we get all this smoke out of the cave? And why are we suddenly so dizzy? Punching a hole in the top of the cave seemed to work well.

Later, when the tepee was erected, the understanding of exhaust and fresh air intake was recognized, as they had a smokestack penetrating the top and air openings in the skirt. Even though an actual open fire with no exhaust in your living area might be uncommon these days, we often overlook the importance of combustion within a tightly built modernized home.

It seems that we may have forgotten the combustion process because many of the houses we grew up in were older and "looser" homes — drafty single-pane windows, cracks in the basement window sills, old doors that didn't shut all the way, spots where you can see daylight to the outdoors and uninsulated steel doors were the norm. These houses usually had very little insulation, large operational chimneys for old fireplaces, gable vents, space vents, vents to the outdoors in old boilers rooms and no vapor barriers.

The space heating and water heating equipment were unsealed open-burn chambers taking combustion air from the basement, which was an oxygen-rich environment because of how much fresh air could quickly be drawn in through this "loose" building structure. The result, most times, was an inefficient burn for each appliance as far as the utility bill was concerned. The combustion, on the other hand, made gas-fired appliances last a very long time because it was able to take the exact amount of air that is required for proper combustion. Because it was designed to operate this way, we routinely run into boilers or furnaces installed in the 1960s and 1970s that still work fine. This is what I call the "tepee effect" — air in, burn, exhaust out, repeat.

So why do many gas-fired units tail within a 10- or 20-year window while the predecessors lasted so much longer? You could argue that the quality of the material is inferior, but the combustion process is also an equally viable answer. Over the past few decades, we have decided to tighten up our houses to maximize energy efficiency. We've replaced those drafty windows with insulated, vacdum-tight windows, insulated the attic, insulated the walls, added vapor barriers, put spray foam in every crack, replaced those wooden or steel doors with high insulation value doors and so on.

Well, guess what? Now your house is very tight -starving for fresh combustion air from the outside and lacking air to draft properly - and we are back to our cave man days to a certain extent. Unless you have a newer furnace or water heater that takes air from the outdoors directly through piping, you have a problem, especially with tank-type water heaters and 50% of furnaces.

Each Bar/h of gas burned requires about 50 cubic feet of air -- that's a lot of fresh air that your customer might not have available. So what happens? The customer will have incomplete and improper combustion. Improper combustion could potentially lead to all sorts of issues

such as overfiring the unit, warping the metal, cracking the heat exchanger, burning recycled exhaust gas, setting off the carbon monoxide alarms and ultimately lead to premature unit failure.

Gas furnaces should be updated to the 90-plus highefficiency units and piped to the outdoors. Too many times we have all seen the exhaust on these units piped outdoors but the fresh air intake is left taking air from the indoor space.

If the customer has a water heater that takes combustion air from the space it's in, make sure you check your code book and installation manual to calculate how much fresh air it needs. Did the customer build a sealed room around their furnace and water heater with no way to get any fresh air? Especially in newer homes, this is standard practice. Can the problem be solved with installing a louvered door to that room to allow fresh air to enter the burn center?

If you have significant concerns after speaking with the customer about routine premature failures, you should do a few things. Check the gas pressure versus the rating tag allowances, do a proper combustion analysis with a combustion analyzer and compare it to the manufacturer's allowances (even if that requires a phone call), and check the draft hoods (if applicable) with a match for back spillage.

We cannot allow builders and homeowners to trade a small percentage of utility or installation savings for a potentially life-threatening situation. Furthermore, we shouldn't allow them to trade in these perceived savings for the cost of unnecessary and excessive repairs and replacement units due to improper combustion.
