







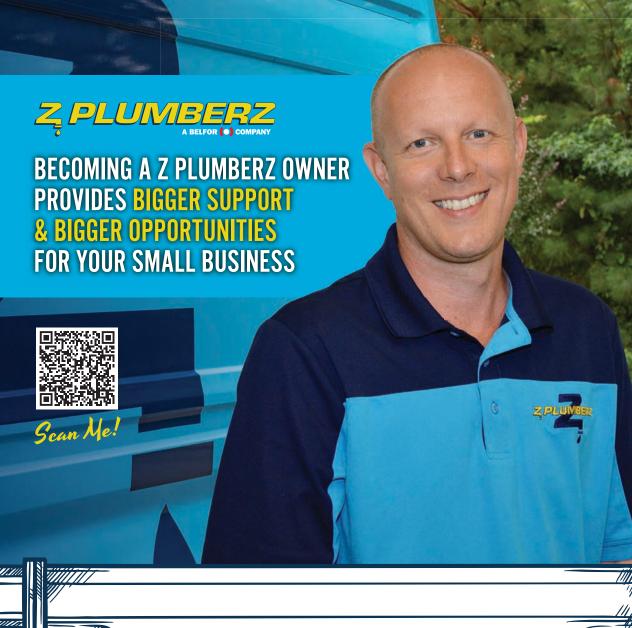

Devoting time to train and get better will provide long-term benefits for your plumbing company

ajor League Baseball teams are wrapping up their regular seasons and preparing for the postseason, while the National Football League is about a month into its regular season.

Every team on the field or ball diamond put in the hard work, training and dedication to get them the start of the season to where they are now. For MLB teams, it's been a long season, but now is the time when it all counts and many of those athletes will perform their best.

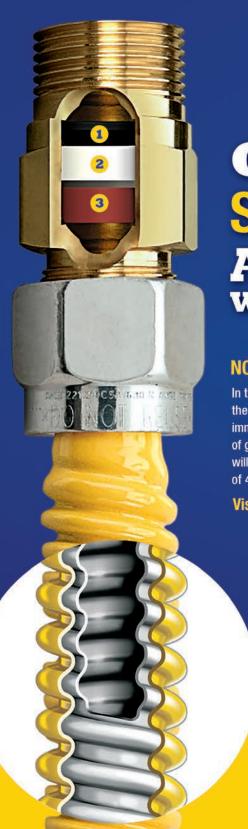

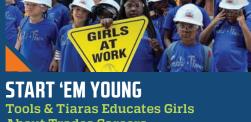

Carrying on THELEGACY

A third-generation plumber and drain cleaner continues a family tradition of quality work

he Halstead name has long been associated with superior drain cleaning and plumbing in Cleveland, Ohio. Now a third generation is well along the family's career path. Josh Halstead has a master plumber's license on his wall and is increasing management responsibility for the family company, whose service area now ranges across a hundred miles.

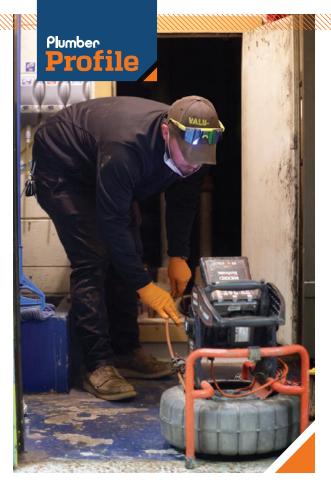
It all began with his grandfather, Robert Halstead, who emigrated from West Virginia to Ohio in 1962. He first worked at a manufacturing facility in Brook Park and then at a plant in Avon. In 1971, he joined the workforce at the Lorain Ford Motor assembly plant, which closed in 2005 after 48 years of production.

More significantly, while working at the Ford plant, he and his brother started a sewer cleaning company on the side. When Robert Halstead had the chance in 1973 to buy the Roto-Rooter franchise for Lorain County, he fully committed to the cleaning industry, leaving Ford behind and operating the franchise for the next 30 years.

Josh Halstead says his grandfather's long involvement in the cleaning industry helped create today's competitive drain cleaning industry in the area. "Grandfather trained up a lot of people around here in drain cleaning, people who went on to start their own gig," Halstead says. "I'll talk to my dad about some company, and he'll say, 'Yes, they used to work for your grandfather back in so and so.' That happens quite a bit."

Halstead's father, Russell, also worked at the family Roto-Rooter business before launching a plumbing and drain cleaning company of his own in 1997, The Personal Plumber. He renamed his company Valu-Rooter in 2006, retaining "The Personal Plumber" as a company trademark.

In November, a full 24 years after being launched and then renamed, Valu-Rooter is going strong and answering service calls across north-central Ohio. Company vans are in and out of Cleveland proper as well as serving a swath of suburbs along the south side of Lake Erie from Painesville on the east all the way to Sandusky on the west and as far south as Akron.

At age 15, Halstead officially began working at the family business, drawing a part-time paycheck. Ten years later, while his father still comes to the office in Elyria "to make sure everything is running smoothly," Halstead serves as field supervisor.

READY TO SERVE

Valu-Rooter is principally a provider of residential services, which partly is a reflection of the changing face of Cleveland itself. Once a center of heavy manufacturing steel, auto production and shipbuilding — the city and its suburbs survived relocation of some of those mainstay industries to other states and the resulting Rust Belt that followed. Today, biomedical, polymer, electronics and engineering are the major industries, with employees scattered among the various suburbs. Continued >

A Rewarding Career

Finding and retaining employees is the biggest challenge facing U.S. trades. Josh Halstead has no secret formula for resolving the dilemma. But the field supervisor of Valu-Rooter, a plumbing and drain cleaning company in Elyria, Ohio, knows this much: A company can't fix it alone.

Valu-Rooter is 24 years old and no one aside from company founder Russell Halstead has exceedingly long tenure. Two current employees did leave and then return, which surely says something good about the company.

Two other technicians joined the firm recently enough that they are still in training. Becoming fully trained might take a little longer at Valu-Rooter than at some firms because the techs are all cross-trained for plumbing, drain cleaning, operating a mini-excavator, installing a new water heater, working on natural gas lines and so on. There's lots to learn.

It's the long-term hiring and retention of employees that concerns Josh Halstead. "Right now, it's hard to find anybody to work here. We've been trying to get more tech trainees, but it's hard."

The company is nonunion and he tells of a "union guy who came up to me and wanted me to jump over to his company. Well, I didn't, and I'm not going to turn away a qualified person who's looking to work here, but if everyone does that, it's not helping."

Halstead recites statistics that tell the story: In Ohio, for every two plumbers or drain cleaners who retire, only one is coming into the industry. That's not a sustainable formula if the trade is to meet the needs of customers in future years.

Instead of new blood entering the trade, Halstead says, experienced hands are moving from place to place within it. "Everyone is trying to talk to my tech or plumber or somebody's else's tech or plumber and persuade him to come to work for them. That's not helping. We are only redistributing the help."

He knows of one Cleveland-area plumbing house that is working with a local high school to encourage teens to enter the trade. He says he's thinking about reaching out to local vocational schools to develop a similar pipeline for young men and women.

"We need to come together as an industry and try hard to persuade the upcoming generation that working in a trade is a great option for them. It is not just a job. It can be a very rewarding career."







Consequently, some 70-80% of the company's business is on residential properties, with perhaps 5% of calls taking techs to industrial settings, the rest being commercial. "Typically, a service call is the clearing of a line at a home along with 'There's also a drip under my sink' kinds of things."

Being able to respond to a variety of tasks on a single service call means the company's eight service vans each carry gear for most routine fixes. RIDGID or MyTana camera systems are there so a technician can visually verify a clogged line problem and its resolution. Traditional cable machines in the trucks are from Duracable. the Des Moines, Iowa, manufacturer.

The latest addition to the company's toolbox is a RIDGID FlexShaft drain machine. "Most of the time drain cleaning is done using the traditional cable, but the FlexShaft is growing in popularity," Halstead says. "Every time I show customers that machine, they quickly see how great it is and they're sold on using it."

He says he especially enjoys using the RIDGID tool in descaling work. "It's so cool that we can grind back cast iron pipe to its regular dimension, saving a customer from having to tear up a drain in his basement."

Cast iron is a common pipe material encountered by drain cleaners in northern Ohio. "Cleveland is an old city," Halstead says, "though it depends on where you go. Some of the suburbs are building a lot of new housing, but we still find clay tile. We still go to places that have original cast iron lines from a hundred years ago."

Valu-Rooter techs have four jetters they can call on to clear a line. Three are Harben single-axle units with 300-gallon tanks and 18 gpm flow at 4,000 psi. A smaller Cam Spray jetter produces 2,800 psi. The ideal pipe diameter to jet is 10 inches, Halstead says, though the larger jetters are rated for 12-inch pipe and occasionally are called upon to clear mud from a storm culvert.

PICKING UP STEAM

If digging is required, the company has a trio of Kubota mini-excavators it can haul to a site. A 28 hp KX91 was acquired about 10 years ago. A 42 hp KX121 was added to the equipment yard eight years ago. A narrower 10 hp model K008 was procured more recently to give techs easier entry into fenced backyards.

The company does all kinds of pipeline excavations, Halstead says. "If water is running through it, we deal with it." That means techs roll out of the equipment yard two or three times a week with an excavator in tow. The other heavy piece of equipment in regular use is a Kubota 65 skid-steer, which mostly is used to load small-diameter stone into dump trucks.

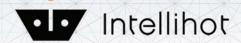

"Excavation work has been picking up, actually," Halstead says, citing recent rains. "In Lorain, sanitary sewer lines tie in with the storm sewer, so when it rains, sewers clog and sewage backs up into basements. When it rains, we're busy in northern Ohio."

The company's main office is on state Route 254 in the county seat town of Elyria, west of Cleveland, with two satellite offices to the east — one in Medina and the other in Willoughby Hills. The latter two locations are mostly warehouse and staging areas for technicians working those parts of the service area, thereby shortening supply lines and response times.

Halstead lives in the Sandusky area farther west along the Lake Erie shore. When service calls are scheduled, he is apt to end up calling on customers between the home office and his home. The busiest service area is in Cleveland and communities on its west side.

The company is a Rheem-certified and Moen-certified dealer and a full-service plumber, but the biggest single component of Valu-Rooter's business remains drain cleaning. As was the case in other parts of the country, clogged pipes became an even bigger problem for homeowners with the onset of COVID-19. "During the pandemic, cleaning pipes picked up quite a bit," Halstead says. "People were staying home and using the facilities more. Some of them learned that this or that didn't go down the drain like they thought it did."

EYE ON THE FUTURE

Halstead wears a variety of hats. Besides periodic service calls on the way home to Sandusky, he supervises other techs, repairs equipment, estimates jobs and calls on his master plumber experience to handle the larger and more difficult plumbing jobs. "Basically, I do whatever is needed."



He also is the point man on large remodeling projects or the renovation of a house that has suffered fire damage. "I love those projects because it can be tricky to ensure the plumbing is brought up to code. I like the challenge, though. That's how you get better. You don't grow by being comfortable, so I welcome getting out of my comfort zone."

As next in line to head the family business, Halstead also has his eye on the future. He is actively interested in having the company offer trenchless repairs, he says, probably starting with pipe patching, then getting into relining or coating. "I've been reading up on it, but before we make a decision we need to talk to vendors." He had planned to thoroughly explore trenchless technology at the 2021 WWETT show in Indianapolis in February, but it was canceled.

For now, the company is concentrating on expanding its service presence in the Cleveland area, with additional trucks. Halstead has his eyes on Columbus as a future satellite location for Valu-Rooter, but there's no timetable for such southward expansion. "We have to get a little bigger in Cleveland first."

Besides the company's eye-catching bright yellow-and-black service vans promoting "The Personal Plumber," marketing of Valu-Rooter is primarily by word of mouth. He runs a few newspaper ads and Google reviews are welcomed, but the company's business base remains referrals and repeat customers.

Halstead attributes such loyalty to the company's belief in customer care. "We strive to take care of our customers. We're not worried about upselling. My dad believes in customer care and our technicians all believe in it. Consequently, our customers trust us, and we get repeat business and referrals."

It's a simple formula, but it works. "I believe in treating customers like you want to be treated, so I recommend to a customer what I would do at my house. You go from there."

Game-Changing Mini Vac

Portable vacuum machine helps employees work smarter and avoid injury Bv Ken Wvsockv

hen Terrance Whitehead, president of Triple J Plumbing, first heard about the Roll-n-Vac industrial-strength, wet-and-dry vacuum machine from Truebite, he sensed it had game-changing potential.

As it turned out, his instincts were correct. The small but powerful machine serves as a mini vacuum truck that increases productivity, reduces on-the-job injuries and boosts profitability, he says.

"For a small investment, you get a taste for the benefits of vacuuming up materials," Whitehead says. "It's a really innovative and ingenious machine."

Simplicity is the machine's calling card. It's essentially just a powerful, industrial-grade electric motor built into a plastic cowling that fits on top of a standard, 6-cubicfoot, construction-grade steel wheelbarrow.

The combination of power and portability makes the Roll-n-Vac a versatile machine. The motor generates 110 cfm of vacuum power; Truebite tests show it can vacuum 200 pounds of sand in three minutes.

DIFFERENT APPLICATIONS

Triple J uses its two machines for everything from removing mud to quickly revealing curb valves to vacuuming sand, pea gravel and other media from trenches to expose pipes that need repair. Moreover, it's then easy and convenient to move the vacuumed materials because they're deposited right into a wheelbarrow, Whitehead says.

"We can run it off a small generator and vacuum up the mud around the valve stem (of a curb box), then take it off the wheelbarrow and put it back on a pickup truck," he says. "We've tried to use a shop vac to do this, but they're just not designed for that kind of job."

Based in New Castle, Indiana, about 45 miles east of Indianapolis, Triple J primarily does commercial plumbing along with some residential work. About half of the work is service and repair and the other half is new-construction

plumbing, Whitehead says.

The company employs 20 people and runs more than a dozen service vehicles, including a Ram ProMaster 3500 van outfitted with a Spartan Ultimate Urban Warrior water jetter (4,000 psi at 21 gpm); Chevrolet 2500 service vans; a Ford Transit van; and RAM 3500 and 2500 pickup trucks outfitted with Knapheide utility bodies.

IMPROVING PRODUCTIVITY

The machine proved its mettle on a recent pipe replacement project.

"We were at an apartment complex where we replaced about 120 feet of 4-inch-diameter cast iron pipe that was about 50 years old and deteriorating badly," Whitehead says. "But the pipe was under a concrete slab in a bed of pea gravel, so we had cut out a trench in the slab to get at the pipe."

At that point, company employees would usually remove the pea gravel with shovels, a very labor-intensive and time-consuming process. For starters, unless the trench is cut very wide, which creates more work for employees and adds cost for customers, it's hard to get a good angle to remove the gravel.

"Second, that pea gravel is always pouring back in while you're digging," Whitehead says. "But now we just roll the Roll-n-Vac up to the trench and it does the job. On a very small scale, it's like having a vacuum truck without spending hundreds of thousands of dollars."

On some jobs, the Roll-n-Vac even enables work crews to cut narrower trenches because workers don't need the extra room to maneuver with shovels, which saves time and labor.

Furthermore, using the Roll-n-Vac significantly reduces the odds of employee injuries like back strains, which are common with the torqueing and twisting that occurs when employees shovel out heavy materials like dirt and gravel, he says.

"You're basically eliminating some manual labor. Digging can be really hard on your back, especially when access (to trenches) is tight. You just stick the hose in the excavation and start vacuuming."

WHEELBARROW REQUIREMENTS

The Roll-n-Vac retails for \$1,824. Features include a float-valve automatic shut-off device, reverse-blowing capability and two 2-inch-diameter hoses, one 10 feet long and the other 20 feet long.

However, the machine doesn't come with a wheelbarrow. which raises one important caveat: Users must buy a construction-grade steel wheelbarrow. (The least expensive wheelbarrow Truebite recommends is the Jackson 6-cubicfoot model made from industrial-grade steel; it sells for about \$130 to \$140 at big-box home-improvement centers like Home Depot and Lowes.)

"If you don't buy the right kind of wheelbarrow, the motor is powerful enough to collapse the wheelbarrow like a tin can," Whitehead says.

The machine is easy to use. The plastic cowling, which includes a rubber gasket along the bottom rim, easily fits over the top of a wheelbarrow, no clamps required. Then just insert the hose, plug the machine into a standard 110volt electrical outlet and go to work, he says.

NEW USES

Whitehead says the company also has used the Rolln-Vac, originally designed for the pool-cleaning industry, to suck water out of sewer lines and even oil-water separators to make camera inspections easier.

"We're constantly finding new ways to use it," he says. "The guys really like them. They improve productivity, make labor less intensive and decrease the chances of our guys damaging lines with shovels.

"They've been such a great investment that we'll probably buy more," he continues. "I think they'll sell like hot cakes when people see what they're capable of doing."

7 Tips for Keeping Employees Engaged

It takes deliberate effort to keep even the best team committed and enthusiastic **By Kate Zabriskie**

"They're here, but they're not here. My staff isn't committed, and it's obvious to me and to our customers. We're in trouble."

"To say that initiative is lacking is an understatement. My staff doesn't think beyond the basics. If they hit a wall, they stop. The idea of looking for a window never crosses their minds."

"Maybe it's them. Maybe it's me. Our team just goes through the motions. I wish there were a magic formula to get people focused and motivated."

While there isn't an instant solution for increasing enthusiasm, focus and initiative, there are steps any leader can take to orchestrate success.

Step 1: Communicate the direction

It's hard for people to reach a destination if they don't know what it is. Whether you call it mission, purpose or something else, employees need to have a solid understanding of the organization's why, the team's why, and their why. Leaders who promote engagement regularly connect day-to-day tasks and expectations with the bigger picture.

Work on creating clear lines of sight, and lay out goals and expectations for your team.

No matter their role or level in an organization, people like to be appreciated and recognized. Whether someone is a vice president or a temporary worker, leaders who engage their teams communicate the idea that everyone has an important role. Take the time to articulate how others contribute. "Eric, you are the first person to have contact with our customers. When people call us for service, you are the person who sets the tone. Thank you for always being professional. You're nailing it."

Step 4: Support stumbles

Slips, trips and mistakes will happen when people try to solve problems, and leaders who engage their teams to the full capacity have the good sense to support the stumbles employees will inevitably encounter. In other words, it's about having the maturity to get beyond blame and focus on what to do differently in the future.

Do you assume the best? Do you steer clear of throwing others under the bus? Do you treat errors as learning opportunities? If not, you've got some room to improve. "Eric, that job did not go as you had hoped, but we can learn from the experience. In hindsight, what could have been done differently?"

Step 5: Instill a sense of calm and certainty

Without a clear course, employees spend a lot of time worrying and focusing on what-ifs that may never happen. But with a sense of certainty, people's shock absorbers function at maximum capacity. A leader with a plan reduces fear, uncertainty and stress.

The plan can be short term and it can change, as long as it's there and communicated. Do you do all you should do to keep people in the loop?

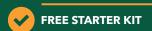

The Pitch

Using this tool can be a big game changer for your plumbing company's revenue goals **By Randy Lorge**

'm about to throw you a pitch that will most certainly be a "game changer" in your plumbing and plumbing-design career. However, before I do that, let me use a few baseball analogies that best describe this new pitch and where it came from.

First, I'll introduce you to the gentleman who originally invented it, or who I'll call the coach. Then, we'll take a brief look at the pitching staff, or the researchers, that advanced it. Finally, I'll give you the pitch or the water demand calculator and show you that, when thrown correctly, how it will give you a win of your own!

THE COACH

I will be the first person to tell you that I have not spent even 1/100 of the amount of time I would need to be a true biographer for Dr. Roy Hunter, but what I will tell you is when it comes to plumbing, he's a legend.

Merriam-Webster defines a coach as "one who instructs or trains." In a roundabout way, Dr. Hunter did exactly that for the plumbing industry. In 1940, he issued "Methods of Estimating Loads in Plumbing Systems" for the National Bureau of Standards. Within that "playbook," Dr. Hunter showed the plumbing industry his "curve" which became known as, yep you guessed it, "Hunter's Curve."

Dr. Hunter considered a plumbing fixture's water flow, duration of flow and the probability that it would be in use. Dr. Hunter created curves for banks of fixtures such as toilets and their GPM flow and did the same for lavatories. Because

each fixture had a different flow rate, Dr. Hunter converted them into a common value, which we call fixture units, and then placed those fixture units into his curve.

THE PITCHING STAFF

Google tells me that the game of baseball was developed somewhere around 1839. I think we can all agree that the game has certainly changed a bit in the past 180 plus years. In fact, if Google is correct, so have the pitches.

We progressed from fastballs, to breaking balls and curveballs to changeups. Then sprinkle in the variations of each category of pitches and the arsenal continues to grow. Likewise, when Dr. Hunter developed his "curve," it was inevitable that it would evolve as the innings (or the years) passed.

His curve underwent modifications by various players. However, it wasn't until around 1996 that Dr. Hunter's curve was sent down to the minors for some severe rehabilitation. The staff that took on the job of getting Dr. Hunter's curve back up to major league form, was ruthless. This group was looking to make his curve the best it ever was.

They studied thousands of variables (single-family homes) to attain important data (water use measurements) and they were relentless. They filled the chalkboard with formulas and values including n (number of fixtures in the dwelling), p (probability that a fixture is in use during the peak period) and q (flow rate at a busy fixture). They still weren't done though. They scoured the list of other coaches

who had worked on Hunters Curve and came across the work done by one named Robert Wistort.

Taking Wistort's work into consideration, they pushed forward to make sure that when their pitch was ready, it would be the game changer the league was desperately in need of. So, while it may have been the longest stint ever in the minors, in 2018, or about 22 years later, an updated version of

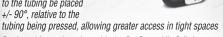

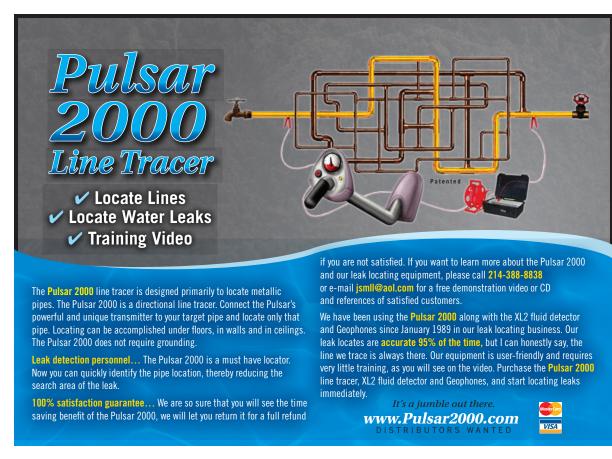

Hunter's Curve came back to the major league of plumbing and was available for all to use in the playbook known as the 2018 Uniform Plumbing Code.

THE PITCH

With the new pitch — or the WDC — ready to use, it was only a matter of time before the players, or the plumbing industry, started learning how to throw it into their pipe sizing calculations.

The WDC took what Dr. Hunter started and put a pitch in the industry's hand, which would go on to strike down the number of gallons per minute of flow in a water distribution system for one- and two-family homes. By striking down the gpm, the next batter up that went 0-3 was pipe sizes. In other words, when the gpm fell to the WDC, so did pipe sizes. They got smaller.

The next power hitter that stepped up to the plate was pricing. This is one of the most feared hitters in the industry! However, he never saw the ball cross the plate because when gpm fell, and then pipe sizes went down swinging, price was due to strike out as well! I think it's also fair to say that the true winner in this game is water. Smaller pipe sizes lead to less water in the pipes for less time. Less time for water in the pipes goes on to promote a safer piping system that is less likely to form bacteria in it!

In a world where winning is everything, I can't imagine why you wouldn't want to take advantage of this pitch to strike out the batter (your competition), in the next game of bidding for a project.

Not only will it give you the opportunity to win, but this pitch, aka the water demand calculator, will be a "game changer" for your team!
